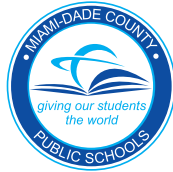
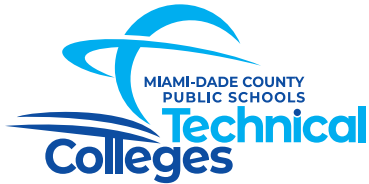

Length of Program
