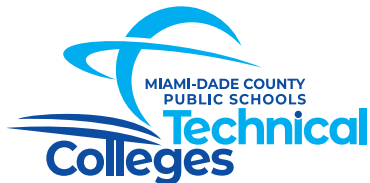

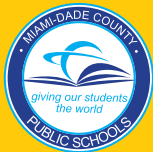

Program Outlook

The Commercial Vehicle Driving program provides students with the technical knowledge and skills needed for employment as Class B drivers in the Commercial Vehicle Driving industry. Instruction includes a combination of classroom theory and practical experience.

Length of Program

The length of this program is 150 hours (approximately 6 weeks) for Class B CDL full-time students.

Entrance Requirements

- Application
- Interview by guidance counselor
- Age: Minimum 21 years
- Assessment in reading, math, and language
- Fees for supplies and textbooks are required
- Health Examination
- Drug Test
- Must qualify for and obtain a CDL Learner's Permit from the Florida Department of Transportation and Motor Vehicles
