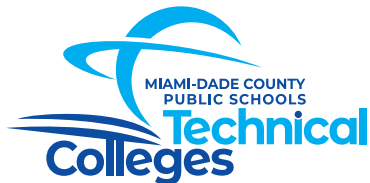

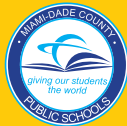

## ➤ Program Outlook

This program focuses on broad, transferable skills and stresses understanding and demonstration of the following elements of the health care industry; planning, management, finance, technical and production skills, underlying principles of technology, labor issues, community issues and health, safety, and environmental issues.

## ➤ Length of Program

The program is 1050 hours in length (approx. 10 months) to complete depending upon enrollment status (full-time or part-time). This program contains several occupational completion points designed to prepare students for various entry level jobs within this occupational area.

## ➤ Entrance Requirements

- Application
- Interview by guidance counselor
- Adult students must be at least 16 years of age and not attending high school
- Assessment in math, language, and reading
- High school diploma or GED
- Fees for supplies and textbooks are required
- Uniform required
